WHAT TO EXPECT

Check-in is from 7:30am to 8:00am. Please notify us prior to 8am if you are running late, and we will attempt to accommodate. **We leave promptly at 8:15am!** (We will have extra liability forms at check-in if anyone has printing issues.)

At 8:15am we drive out to the site in a single column. This drive takes about 15min.

Once parked at the site, all new participants will be put through an orientation. This orientation/tour takes approx. 30min. and includes information on proper formation identification and some interesting paleontology/geology exhibits to look out for.

At the end of orientation, tools are provided to get started finding fossils. (around 9:05am)

All food, water, hats, etc. must be brought with you; there is no availability at the dig site. (It will be over an hour round trip into town to get anything.)

We have some picnic tables for your use; but, most just tailgate in our parking lots.

No alcohol or controlled substances permitted at the dig site.

You are free to leave at any time; we close our gates at 5pm.

Most with children make it till around 1pm, depending on their ages and the weather.

Groups of 10 or more require a deposit of \$300. This deposit will be refundable up to ten (10) days prior to your dig.

A smoking area can be provided at certain times of the year. Please ask and you can be directed to it.
